- Students who cancel their housing after selecting/ being assigned housing will not receive the commitment fee back as part of our process. The balance of the housing cost will be prorated based on the Bursar's



General Questions Regarding Housing Costs

The Housing Commitment Fee:

• The commitment fee is a part of your semester housing fees. It is a \$3,000/semester of the overall housing costs.

Cancellation Example:

\$4,944/semester - \$3,000 commitment fee = \$1,944 potential max. refund

• Students who cancel their housing after selecting/ being assigned housing will not receive the commitment fee back as part of our process. The balance of the housing cost will be prorated based on the Bursar's refund schedule.

Billing:

- Billing for fall 2022 semester will happen in July 2022
- Billing for spring 2022 will happen in November 2022

Financial Aid Questions

 The Office of Residential Life and Learning does not take payments for housing and thus are unable to discuss the specifics of your questions regarding your financial aid. Questions for your Financial Aid should be directed to Student Services.



Timeline and Application Process

Applications for On-Campus Housing will be available for graduate students now and will be available until early-June. Housing selection will take place in mid-June.


To access the application:

Our office can assist with navigating the off-campus housing process.


