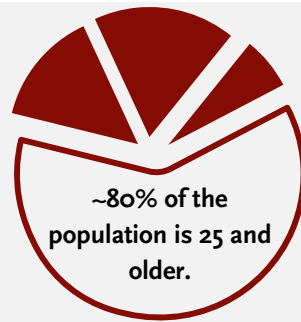

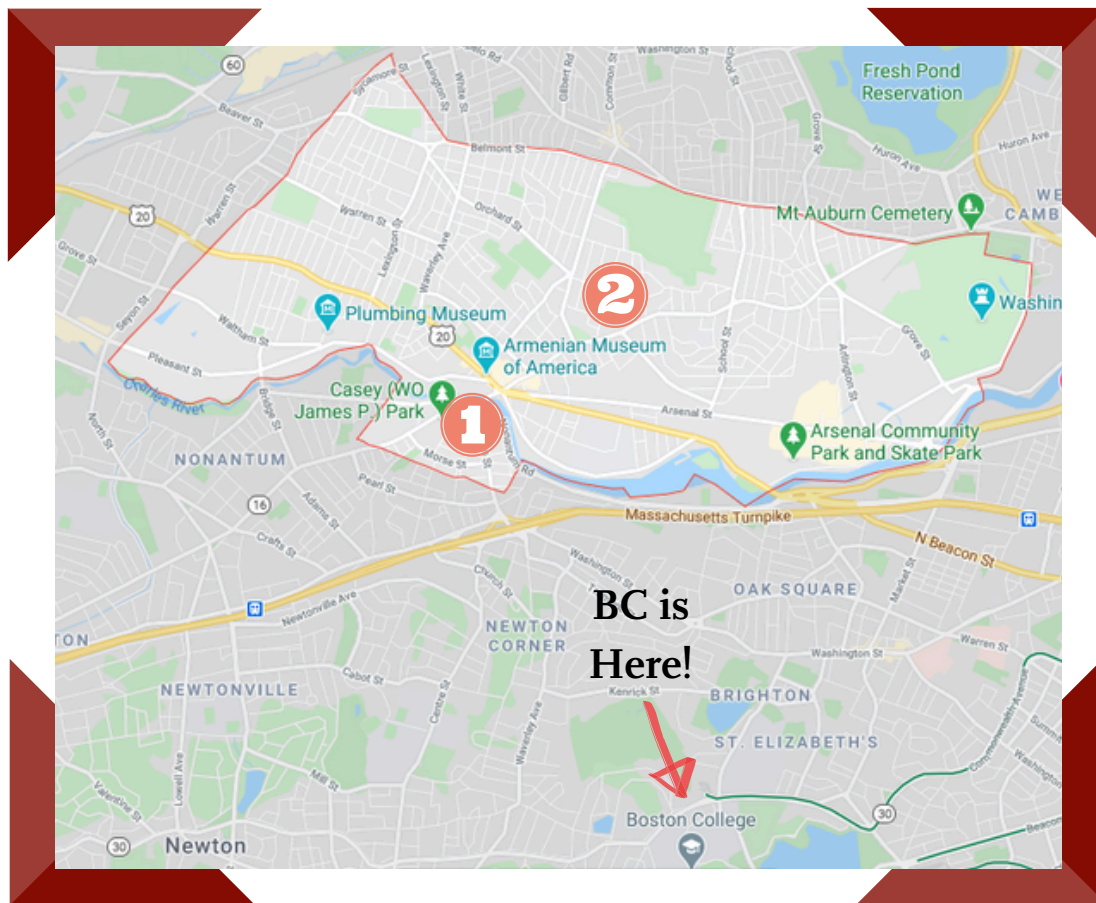

- The 57 Bus is the primary mode of public transit in the area to Boston College and Chestnut Hill.
- The 57 Bus runs from Watertown Yard to Kenmore--the main bus and T hub--where you can take the Green Line B branch to BC.

- Given its distance from campus and primary methods of public transit, as well as the difficulty of biking during the winter, having a car is ideal in this area.



Average Times to Commute to Campus*

- Walking: Not considered within walking distance from most departure points.
