



COMMUTING AROUND BRIGHTON



- → The 57 Bus runs from Watertown Yard to
 Kenmore--the main bus and T hub that connects
 to downtown Boston!
- → The 57 Bus cuts through Brighton on Washington St. and Commonwealth Ave.

- → The 86 Bus runs from the intersection of Washington St. and Chestnut Hill Ave.
- Taking the 86 Bus "Inbound toward Reservoir" will bring you to the Green Line B branch which ends at Boston College's Chestnut Hill campus

- This is the Green Line B branch, which ends at the footsteps of BC's Chestnut Hill campus.
- This is a part of the MBTA "Green Line," so it also connects to downtown! At the Kenmore Station you can hop on other Green Line branches.



Average Times to Commute to Campus*

- Walking: From most departure points it takes
 <30 min. to walk to BC.
- Driving: 7-15 min. (Note: Limited street parking)
- MBTA: 5-10 min. on the T; 25-35 min. by bus & walking.

*Commute times are averages based on normal road and/or weather conditions. Please stay up to date on local road work and forecasts.
